

Under the circumstances it was a very good run by the horse. After that run, his track work picked up and we were given the tip by our new track rider Neville, "this horse should win his next start." And what do you know, Neville was right. When back to Kembla on the 16th, our jockey, Rob Brewer was told, 'this time: Just sit on him and let him find his comfort zone, whether that be leading; mid field, or wherever, Sacred must be not pushed or pulled!' It paid off big time with an impressive win, over the 1400 journey. He will return to Kembla on the 3rd, to once again take on the 1400. If he wins, or runs a close placing Wade will take him to Canterbury two weeks later for a 1550 race.

I shall keep you all informed, and affirmed of this date plus your horses' progress.




